

HIGH RISK WARRANT SERVICE

Description: This two day course is based on the component parts of tactical entry situation - teams/officers approach, breaching, entry/clear, suspect control and stand down procedures. The course provides tactical officers with the basic level of training of entering a structure. Combining tactical shooting skills with operational techniques, the course provides tactical training for warrant service situations and other incidents where an entry has been chosen to resolve the situation.

The course is designed as a hands-on operator course which incorporates tactical firearm's skills, live-fire room clearing techniques (covert, slow and controlled deliberate). The course provides patrol/tactical officers the opportunity to train together and hone their skills.

Topics covered include:

- Warrant vs. Barricade Situation Comparison
- Criteria for Requesting SWAT for HRWS
- Knock & Announce and Time of Service Considerations
- Scouting Missions
- Warrant Service Planning - Development of Tactical Plan
- Reconnaissance and Intelligence gathering
- UAV considerations - aerial reconnaissance photography
- Deployment and Execution of Warrant
- Points of Entry and Breaching Considerations - Equipment
- Deployment of Containment Personnel
- Interior Team Movement Clearing Drills
- Suspect Control
- Interior Team Movement W/Secondary Room Clear Practicals
- Officer Down Practical - movement/equipment needed

- Tactical Firearm Drills - Officer Ambush
- Active Shooter Response/Tactical Movement Drills
- Low Light Shooting Drills
- Immediate Action Drills
- Use of distraction devices and NFDD delivery equipment

Shoothouse ammunition will be provided with the course cost. The training center stocks 9mm, .40 S&W and .45 ACP. If your weapon system requires a different caliber, please notify the training staff prior to the course. \$375 per officer, class time 0800-1600 and 14 POST Credits.
