



ANNANDALE TACTICAL TRAINING CENTER SHOOHOUSE INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Description: The two day, 16 hr shoothouse instructor course is designed to provide firearms instructors methods in developing and executing safe live-fire and realistic training for their officers. The course will also provide the instructor all the necessary information regarding the rental of the training center and its resources for their department's training program. The officers are taught in the following topics:

- Range and shoothouse safety rules
- Transitioning officers from the range to a live-fire shoothouse
- Target systems and target placement
- Instructor responsibilities
- Instructor/student ratios
- Participant conducted live-fire scenarios
- Low light firing

Ammunition will be provided with the course cost. The training center stocks 9mm and .40 S&W. If your weapon system requires a different caliber, please notify the training staff prior to the course. Lunch will be provided on both days of training. Hours of class 0800-1600 both days. Cost of two day course - \$425.

Equipment Needed:

- Body armor (tactical armor)
- Wraparound eye protection
- Ear Protection
- Weapon light(s)
- Pistol
- Sub-gun (optional)
- Duty Holster
- Flashlight (red lense optional)

NOTE: As of January 01, 2012, any certified "Shoothouse Instructor" who received their certificate of completion between 2000 and 2008 must be re-certified in the new one day "Shoothouse Instructor Re-Cert". The one day, eight hour course will include all of the information that was presented to you in the original "Shoothouse Instructor" including new live fire entry drills and updated equipment at the facility. After completing either the instructor or update course, your certificate will be valid for five years from the course date. The cost of the one day update is \$185 and the instructor course still remains at \$425, both classes include the price of ammunition.
